

Concrete pouring to be completed this week

Work at Washburn Way and South Sixth Street continues day and night as crews labor over improving one of Klamath County's busiest intersections.

Construction, which closed the intersection to one lane of traffic on Washburn Way, is on schedule, said Lewis Friend, an engineer with ZCS Engineering. Crews are expected to finish pouring concrete by the end of the week.

Construction and installation of traffic signals is next on the agenda, along with sidewalk work. Workers will also do landscaping and other cleanup work around several businesses before the project is complete.

Access to local businesses remains open while the intersection is under construction.

The project is scheduled to be completed in mid-October.
